FREE COMMUNITY HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP

On 13th of November, 2019 the health care committee successfully organized one community health check up camp. The camp was a grand success with more than 200 patient registration. It was a collaborative program with Zoram Medical Center, Falkawan. Five doctors namely Dr. John, Dr. David, Prof. Haren Baruah, Dr. Themrei, Dr. Mapuia Pautu and one technician M.S. Thari actively



took part in the camp. The director, ZMC Prof. Lallukhum Fimate has participated in the program. He was the chief guest of the program.

At 10.00 AM the program was inaugurated by Dr. Tawnenga, Principal, Pachhunga University College. He also delivered a welcoming speech. The inaugural session was chaired by the committee chairperson Dr. Pauline. Prof. Lallukhum Fimate expresses the needs of such a collaborative program in future too. It was a brief session and finished with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Ghanashyam Deka, secretary of the cell.

After the inaugural session, the health check up camp was opened for the community patient. It was confined to the PUC fraternity and the common people of the College Veng area. More than 200 patients in total were registered in the camp. Minimum medicines were provided to the needy people. Apart from this, RBS, RE, BP etc. also checked up during the camp. Among the doctors one child specialist was there which was highly appreciated by the locals.

The camp was closed at 1.00 PM. which was later followed by lunch at the college canteen.
