E. BRIEF SUMMARY

The total responses received for Pachhunga University College Teachers' Feedback was 116. The Feedback form demanded feedback from four main points such as (a) Curriculum Design and Development (b) Teaching, Learning, Evaluation and Research (c) Infrastructure and (d) Governance. The first main point contains six sub-points, the second contains twenty-one sub-points, the third main point contains ten sub-points and the last main point contains seven sub-points. Altogether the Feedback form contains 44(forty-four) sub-points. Feedback received on all points from all main points is displayed above.

The main points of the Teachers' Feedback received can be summarised as under:
