# Administrative responsibility

- 1. Formation of website committee
- 2. Change on old notice board.
- 3. To design Co-curricular activities for College
- 4. Propose BSc biotechnology/BCA/B.Com (IT) on 12<sup>th</sup> plan
  - To notify each teacher that the number of seminar/workshop attended by a teacher may be limited in such a way that it does not affect Academic Points as prescribed by UGC. This will not hamper teachers' API.
- a) 1 week workshop: Teachers may be allowed to participate once every semester.
- b) 2-3 day workshop/seminar: Teacher may be allowed to participate twice every semester.
- c) 1 day workshop: Teacher may be allowed to participate twice every semester.
- d) Orientation and Refresher course may be arranged during exam/semester break. Special cases may be considered by the Administration.
- e) The leave for each teacher for workshop/seminar/symposia may be limited to 14 days per semester.
- 5. BPL scholarship scheme may be continued
- 6. Incentives to outstanding persons may be created in the form of felicitation.

• Red ribbon club may organize Health awareness campaign and free clinic at the campus.

#### **Student welfare Committee**

 Parents-Teachers Association may be formed for input analysis. PTA may be created in the following format: For arts, science and commerce.

#### **Alumni Association**

- Alumni Programme Officer may be created with one assistant.
- Alumni Association may be made active. This may be achieved by organizing a special programme for alumni two times a year eg. on foundation day.

#### Co curricular activities

- Botany: Identification of exotic plant species imported as agricultural/horticultural items
- Chemistry: Identification of chemical pollutants within Aizawl City
- Physics: Identification of source of radiation, its safety and possible effects (Eg Cobalt therapy Centre)
- Zoology: To Organize a field study of campus organisms
- Statistics: To Analyze the Agriculture product data within the past 10 years
- Mathematics: Multi-grade level math be shown for fun to render creativity and enhance productions for college math students, to show some course concepts to elementary school students.
- Geology: To study the effect of sand mining and effects on Rivers.

- Students may be taken to observe Assembly sessions/AMC sessions
- The actual use of RTI on any fields
- Acting out Plays for English and Mizo Departments
- Cultural programme at DDK
- Organize talk show

#### **Project and IT Committee**

- 1. Project and IT Committee may search for collaborative research work with State Government Department/Research institute/University
- 2. All teachers should be trained to use modern technology viz., Smart board/LCD projectors. This will be organized by Project and IT Committee.
- 3. Non teaching staff's must be trained in DTP works basically Ms Word and Ms Excel. This will include all laboratory staffs.
- 4. Project and IT Committee should inform all the research schemes available to teachers viz. of UGC-minor/Major, DST women Scientist Scheme, other projects from ministry of DONER/NEC. Readymade format may be made available in the website

#### Website committee

1. Technology up gradation- All departments may have a separate website through the college main website. This may be utilized for e-learning centre.

# **Seminar and workshop Committee**

- 1. To formulate the workshop and Seminar for each department
- *IQAC Proposal* (All departments shall be encouraged to organize seminar or Workshop. College may provide fund @ Rs 5000 state level and Rs 1000 Departmental level for each department per academic year.)
- 2. All workshop/seminar should be recorded in the prescribed format so that proceedings of all seminar and workshop may be published at the end of the year.
- 3. All application for departmental seminar/workshop may be informed to the secretary workshop and seminar committee for documentation.

### Career and guidance cell

- 1. Career and Counseling cell may organize campus recruitment at the end of each III<sup>rd</sup> year/6<sup>th</sup> Semester exam.
- 2. Career and Counseling cell may publish a booklet for students for admission to P.G, Career opportunities in professional line and Job opportunities after Graduation.
- 3. Career and Counseling cell may be opened once a week 3-4 pm for counseling. Notice should be given to all students regarding this matter.
- 4. Career and guidance cell may organize **career day** every semester for each departments. Each department may organize such events in consultation with Career Guidance cell. Remuneration for invited person will be provided.

#### **Departmental Responsibilities**

- 1. Every student who fails in their internal test may be subjected to counseling and motivational activities by the department and to keep record of each session.
- 2. Each department have to organize **career day** every semester in consultation with career and counselling cell.
- 3. Each department have to make a report of department activities in a given format (DMR Report)
- 4. Each department have to propose two journals with subscription fee not exceeding Rs. 4000/-per annum. This should be submitted to the principal before 31st July 2011.
- 5. Each teacher has to solve/explain old external question papers (Objective type and short notes) in the classrooms after completion of each unit.
