

**Table : Internal Assessment Test Result Analysis (Final Year) 2016 – 2021**

In this assessment, the attainment level of students is divided into three levels:

**Level 1** – students securing less than 10 marks out of 25

**Level 2** - students securing between 10 and 20 marks out of 25

**Level 3** - students securing more than 20 marks out of 25

The average percentage of students securing above 20 out of 25 marks in five years, i.e. from 2016 – 2021 is 67.69%, This signifies that the highest percentage of students fall under Level 3 category. Since Level 3 carries a weightage of 3 points, the attainment level is 3. The raw score of 3 points is converted into percentage, which is 100%.
