In this assessment, the attainment level of students is divided into three levels:

Level 1 - students securing less than 10 marks out of 25
Level 2 - students securing between 10 and 20 marks out of 25
Level 3 - students securing more than 20 marks out of 25

The average percentage of students securing above 20 out of 25 marks in five years, ie. from $2016-2021$ is $67.69 \%$, This signifies that the highest percentage of students fall under Level 3 category.
