Since the average percentage of students progressing to higher classes in five years, i.e. from 2016 - 2021 is $54.95 \%$, the attainment level falls under Level 2 category which carries a score of 2 points. The raw score of 2 points is converted into percentage, which is $66.67 \%$. Thus, the college scores $66.67 \%$ in students' progression.
