# REPORT OF THE CSUO National Cadet Corps AIR WING



CSUO K. Lawmsangzuala

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the youth wing of Indian forces which is open to schools and colleges on a voluntary basis. The motto of NCC is "Unity and Discipline" and it is the largest uniformed youth organisation in the world.

The aim of the organisation is to inculcate a good character, discipline, comradeship, secular outlook, spirit of adventure and the ideals of selfless service among the youth of this great country.

Pachhunga University College Air Wing NCC was established under the NCC Unit of 1<sup>st</sup> Mizo Air Squadron NCC which is currently commanded by Wing Commander S Nitin. The Unit was raised on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2011 and within a span of only 10 years it has developed immensely and has been integrated to one of the most technologically advanced NCC units in the entire country having two aircrafts and a flight simulator which serves the purpose of giving the cadets an experience of flying which aims to awaken their interest towards the Air Force. Regular flying experience classes are being conducted at Lengpui Airport where the cadets fly with the Commanding Officer in the aircraft.
