



# REPORT OF THE National Cadet Corps ARMY

As a Senior Under Officer, on behalf of Pachhunga University College NCC (Army) it is with great pleasure and under the guidance of our almighty God that I am given the opportunity to write a brief report of the various activities and programmes of PUC NCC throughout 2018-2019 session.

The National Cadet Corps is the World's largest informal Youth organization. The motto of NCC is "UNITY and DISCIPLINE". It is the Youth Wing of the Armed forces with its headquarters located at New Delhi, Lt. Gen Ranjiv Chopra (AVSM) is the current Director General of NCC. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-service organization, comprising of the Army, Navy & Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country to be disciplined and patriotic citizens. It is being operated in schools and colleges among students' on a voluntary basis, in order to develop them for national security in the coming future.

The Cadets are given basic Military training which includes parades on the celebration of Republic Day held in Delhi and in various others places. The NCC in India was formed under the National Cadet Corps Act of 1948. It was raised on 15 traced back to the Corps which was created under the Indian Defence Act 1917, with the objective to meet up the shortage of the Army. The flag of NCC depicts the services in the corps- Red for Army, Deep Blue for Navy and Light blue for Air Force.

The National Cadet Corps of Pachhunga University College was established in the year 1964, under the supervision of the 20th MIZO COY NCC and is the first NCC unit established in Mizoram.
