
GUIDELINES FOR CLUBS

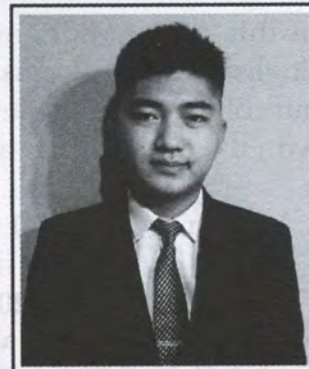

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REPORT OF THE CSUO National Cadet Corps AIR WING

The National Cadet Corps is a youth development movement and the largest uniformed organisation in the world. The motto of NCC is 'UNITY AND DISCIPLINE'. The aims of NCC is to develop character, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure and the ideals of selfless service amongst the youth of the country. It provides opportunities to the youth of the country for their all round development with a sense of duty, commitment, dedication, discipline and moral values so that they become leaders and useful citizens.

1 MIZO AIR SQN NCC was established on 23 May, 2011 under the command of Wg Cdr R Punia and Pachhunga University College, Air Wing NCC was established in the year 2013 which is currently commanded by Sqn Idr MK Singh. Mizoram Air Wing NCC Units are technologically advanced as compared to other units having two aircraft (Zenith STOL CH 701) and a flight simulator.
