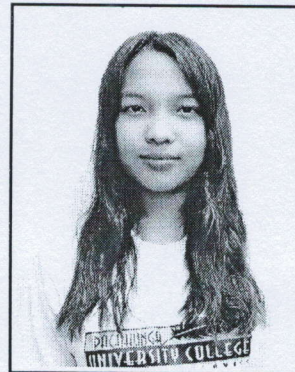




REPORT OF THE SECRETARY Chess Club
