


Cleanliness & Beautification

1. Regular cleaning schedule on college campus is prepared for the cleaners. Their assigned cleaning areas are inspected by the proctor and staffs assigned.
2. The Principal instructed all the teaching staffs to spend at least 15 minutes of their class on importance of cleaning.
3. Readymade presentation file was handed out by principal on importance of cleaning, ethics of clean living which was an important message delivered to every fresher on their first day at college.
4. Garbage collected from the colour coded dustbins are transported, sorted, segregated and treated at the waste management site within the campus.
5. Every Friday afternoon class is engaged for co-curricular activities which is periodically used for campus cleaning to make the campus litter free campus. This class is also occasionally engaged for cleaning in the local community.

Electronic equipment, laboratory equipment, furnishings and other resources which are an important part of college infrastructure are cleaned regularly by the laboratory staffs and at periodic intervals by students supervised by the teachers to prevent from dust, dirt and rubbish which can hamper these things from running efficiently.
7. All the buildings are given fresh painting to improve the aesthetics of the campus.
8. Beautiful flowers and palms are planted at different locations to enhance the natural beauty of the campus.
9. Maintaining a clean college environment sets a good example to students. It encourages learners to take pride in their university or college, which makes them less likely to drop litter and as such they will potentially make a bigger effort to maintain their environment.
