
**Membership Report:**

Membership Drive was held during 9th – 12th July, 2019 in various places within the college campus. A record breaking 450 members signed up this year. Annual membership fee of Rs. 20/- was collected from each members.


Besides the regular members, the Club is proud to have 5 Patron Members, who are mostly seniors who have graduated from the college. Patron Members pay a membership fee Rs. 100/- which last for 5 years.

Activities :

1. The Club organised a seminar on the topic 'Mizo Mythology and Its Significance In Contemporary Literature' on 6th September, 2019 at the College Seminar Hall. C.Lalnunchanga and Lalrammawia Ngente, two renowned writers were invited as the Resource Persons.
2. As part of its Fund Raising activity, the Club set up a stall on the closing day of the College Week.
3. The Club Room which was once small and congested was extended as per the Principal's permission on 17th August, 2019.
4. The Club organised a 'Trash Free Campus Challenge' and 'Book Challenge' during the month of August to October. Prize distribution for these challenges was held on 9th November, 2019. The winner for Book Challenge was Zolianchami Pachuau, V Semester Dept. of History and V Semester Department of Public Administration won the Trash Free Campus Challenge.
5. The Club was invited as audience on In-House Star Challenge on 14th September and 2th October, 2019 which was also a part of fund raising activity.
6. The Club in collaboration with the College Library launched The Little Library on 15th November, 2019. Dr. Z.R. Thiamsanga, MLA & Chairman, Health and Family Welfare Board opened this Little Library.
7. The Club also collaborated with Ms. Lalrinliani in selling "Thlaler Aurawl", a book written by her son, Mafaa Hauhnar.
8. The Club is planning to publish a book by this academic session and certain measures have been taken up regarding it. However, due to the unfortunate global pandemic, we are unable to publish during the session.
