SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE, PUC

- 1) MEETINGS CONDUCTED- Two meetings were conducted during this period on 30th July, 2019 and 12th March, 2020.
- 2) FUND STATUS: In the meeting held on 12th March, 2020, the Chairman gave a detail account on the fund status of the project. Out of the total amount of Rs. 9,00,160/- (Rs. Nine lakhs one hundred sixty only) sanctioned by UD & PA, as first installment, the current balance amount is Rs 2,45,750/- (Rs. Two lakhs, forty-five thousand seven hundred fifty only).

3) VERMICOMPOSTING PLANT:

Dr. Lalthanzara in charge of the vermicomposting plant inform in the meeting held on 12th March, 2020 that the Vermicomposting plant have become fully operational. In the first phase of vermicomposting conducted in Mid-July 2019, it gave a result of 80% decomposition rate. In the second phase of Vermicomposting carried out during October 2019 using paper waste and cow dung was very successful. Four cement bags of vermicompost were harvested and it was utilized in the beautification and gardening of the college campus.

4) ANALYSIS OF COMPOST: Analysis of the compost for different parameters were carried out in Botany Depay under the supervision of Dr. P.C. Vanlalhluna.

5) WASTE PAPER AND RECYCLABLE WASTE MATERIALS:

The segregated waste collected from different buildings and disposal points should be collected and kept in the segregation house. Here waste papers and the recyclable waste materials should be collected and the project staff should contact interested buyers of recyclable waste
