MAJOR ACTIVITIES

One-day Programmes:

- 3rd August, 2019: The first One-day Training for the session was held within the College campus where practical classes on Rope Knots, Jumaring and Basic Rappelling Technique were held. A total of 31 members attended this programme.
- 17th August, 2019: The second One-day Training was held within the College campus. 24 members attended this programme. Rappelling, Jumaring and Rope knots were practiced.
- 31st August, 2019: One-day Training was held at World Bank road where cliff rappelling, Overhang rappelling and Rope Knots were practiced. A total of 27 members attended this programme.
- 6th September, 2019: Familiarisation Exercise and Awareness Programme on Disaster Management was held successfully in collaboration with Aizawl District Disaster Management Authority (ADDMA) and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF). Over 100 members attended this programme.
- 28th September, 2019: The first outing programme for the session was held on this day with Thenzawl as destination. NEC park and Tuirihiau Falls were visited. 25 members attended this programme.



- 19th October, 2019: One-day Training was held within the College campus where practical classes on Commando Bridge, Upward Traversing and rappelling were conducted. 25 members attended this programme.
- 25th January, 2020: One-day Training was held within the College campus where training on Basic First Aid and Rescue Techniques was conducted. 26 members attended this training programme.
- 1st February, 2020: One-day Training was held within the College campus. Classes on Rappelling, Rope knots and other different activities were conducted. 26 members attended this programme.
- 8th February, 2020: Exploration of Pakaw Pûk, near Sairang was successfully conducted on this day. 27 members and 1 Ex-Office Bearer attended this programme.

WINTER CAMP:

The Winter Camp-cum-Expedition was held successfully during 6th - 12th January, 2020 at the state of Meghalaya. 24 members along with 2 Ex-Office Bearers attended this camp. Details of the time spent are as follow:

- **6th January, 2020:** On the first day, we began our journey to Meghalaya in the early morning at 4:40 A.M. We spent the whole day on the road and arrived at Shillong Mizoram House at 10:00 P.M.
- **7th January, 2020:** On this day, we left Mizoram house at 6:30 A.M. for Dawki. We reach Dawki a little late than planned as a minor problem on our bus delayed our trip for a little while. We spent the rest of the day settling our base camp and visiting Indo-Bangladesh border.
- **8th January, 2020:** The first half of the day was spent at Dawki. We left at 11:00 A.M. for Mawlynnong and Wahkhen. Due to the reoccurrence of a problem in our bus, we could not complete the plan for the day and headed back to Shillong after multiple stop at several work shop. We spent the night at Shillong Mizoram house.
- **9th January, 2020:** As our bus was considered fit again for the trip thanks to the hard work of our drivers, we started a trip to Wahkhen at 6:30 A.M. and reached Wahkhen at around 10:00 A.M. After witnessing a cultural dance demonstrated by the villagers, we set up our base camp near the riverside. On the latter half of the day, we visit Mawryngkhang experiencing a thrilling trek along the way. The night was spent at our base camp.





- **10th January, 2020:** On this day, we visit a very unexplored living root bridge near the village of Wahkhen. The trek leading to this root bridge took around 2 hours to complete. After reaching our destination, we headed back for our base camp and spent the night there.
- **11th January, 2020:** We left Wahkhen for Shillong at 7:00 A.M. and reach Shillong around 9:30 A.M. The members were given the day to be spent in accordance to their will. The last night of the Expedition was spent in Shillong Mizoram house.
- **12th January, 2020:** We left Shillong at 5:00 A.M. for Aizawl with a feeling of satisfaction, leaving behind unforgettable memories. After spending the day on the road, we reached Aizawl at 8:30 P.M.


