

REPORT OF THE MONITOR Boys' Hostel

Pachhunga University College Boys' Hostel has been very fortunate to have witnessed its 45th Year of existence since its establishment in 1975 and is indeed an immense pleasure for me to give a report on the academic session 2019-2020.

The Boys' Hostel has not only been the place of temporary accommodations for the students during their academic sessions at the College but also the cradle of leadership, discipline, manners, etiquettes and many more benevolent qualities which are needed for one's life in the long run. The hostel consists of two buildings viz. Chhinlung and Zawlbuk. It was re-opened on 26th June 2019 with 178 students who came from different parts of the State. The boarders consist of 56 I Semester students, 59 III Semesters, 57 V Semesters and 6 Post Graduate students.

The incumbent warden Dr R. Ramthara appointed three boarders among the V Semester students to superintend the welfare of the boarders during the academic session. They are:

Highlights of Activities:

- 1) The Freshers' Social Function was organised on 17th August 2019. Our respected Principal Dr. Tawnenga served as the Chief Guest. Several dignitaries were present and the programme ended with a feast.
- 2) Hostel Week of the Boys' and Girls' Hostels took place during 31st August to 7th September, 2019. During the Week, the two hostels (Boys' & Girls') were divided into four teams/houses and different competitions were held during the weekends. Among the Houses Black House ended up as the overall House Champion.

- 3) The Hostel indigenous football tournament 'Hostel Premier League' was held during 25th January 2020 to 1st February 2020. At this League, Six teams participated and V. Puppet FC was the Champion of the tournament.
