

REPORT OF THE MONITRESS Girls' Hostel

It is a great pleasure and privilege for me to give the annual report on the management and activities of Girls' Hostel, Pachhunga University College during the academic session 2019-2020. The hostel consists of two buildings namely Zamzo (Old Building) and Senhri (New Building). A quarters is attached here with the hostel for the residence of both the Warden and Chowkidar. The hostel was re-opened on 29th June 2019 with 190 boarders. Students of all streams i.e, Arts, Science and Commerce resided in the hostel. These students came from different parts of Mizoram as well as from the neighbouring state. The boarders are usually classified as Fresher Boarders (1st & 2nd Semester) consisting of 76 boarders, Senior Boarders (3rd & 4th Semester) consisting of 60 boarders and Seniomost boarders (5th & 6th Semester) consisting of 54 boarders.

HOSTEL STAFF:

The current warden is Dr. C. H. Nalini Devi from the Department of Commerce, PUC, who guides and regulates the hostel administration. The other hostel staff members consist of one Chowkidar and three cooks. Both the Warden and Chowkidar dwell in the two quarters attached to the hostel.

1. The Hostel Committee is held on the first week of every month during the session. The Warden and in-charges decide the hostel administration, dating the events and functions of the hostel.
2. The 'Freshers' Social' which is held every year to welcome the new boarders was held on 27th July, 2019.
3. Joint Hostel Week with the Boys' Hostel was held during 31st August-7th September 2019 which builds a strong bond and friendship amongst the hostel boarders.
4. Devotional Service is held twice a week i.e, on Wednesday and Sunday evenings. The offerings collected during this service are to be used in numerous ways especially given for charity.
5. On 3rd November 2019, a heart warming Advance Christmas was celebrated. This particular event was celebrated joyously which makes the event a memorable one.
