Girl Up's leadership development program transforms girls by increasing their leadership skills, connecting them to a global network and positioning them to be changemakers in their communities.

With more than **5,000** Girl Up Clubs in **130** countries, Girl Up brings together thousands of girl activists and a million supporters spanning the globe, inspiring a generation of girls to be a force for gender equality and social change.

Girl Up was founded by the **United Nations**Foundation in 2010 and continues to work across a global community of partners to achieve gender equality worldwide, contributing to the achievement of the global Sustainable Development Goals.



Girl Up India is launching a **10 week long**Apprentice Hub to support **young women**between the **ages of 18-26 years**, to hone their entrepreneurial skills and become future successful entrepreneurs.

#### **Objectives:**

- To provide budding women entrepreneurs the opportunity to cultivate their entrepreneurial skills
- 2. To give them a platform to organise longterm social action projects
- 3. To provide exposure, training and mentorship to young women, thereby increasing their confidence and risk-taking abilities
- 4. To connect young entrepreneurs with stalwarts from the business community and with appropriate resources
- To create a culture of entrepreneurship in the country
