#### **ABOUT THE CONFERENCE**

Sustainable development has evolved as a vital aim for civilizations globally in an era of constantly shifting global issues. As we attempt to strike a balance between economic growth, social fairness, and environmental protection, it is critical to pay attention to rural economies, which frequently play a vital role in the landscape of sustainable development. This academic seminar will investigate and debate ideas, best practises, and novel ways to manage sustainable development, with a focus on rural economies.

# **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

Pachhunga University College (PUC) is a public institute in Aizawl, Mizoram, and the only constituent college of Mizoram University, a central university established by an Act of Parliament of India. Founded in 1958 as Aijal College, it is the oldest and largest college in Mizoram, by enrolment and campus size. The 138-acre campus is the only verdant forest reserve in Aizawl, and is referred to as the "lung of the city." For its conservation of forests, it received the Indira Priyadarshini Vrikshamitra Awards in 1995, a national award for pioneering and innovative works in afforestation and wasteland management, from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India. It received the Best College award from the Zoram Research Foundation, consecutively in 2004 and 2006. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council classified it as B grade with a cumulative grade point average of 2.78 in 2011, and raised it to A+ grade with a CGPA of 3.47 in 2022, the highest score in Northeast India. The National Institutional Ranking Framework listed it among the best 150 colleges in India (rank band within 101-150). In 2017, the University Grants Commission made it College with Potential for Excellences In 2022, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council classified it as A+ grade with a CGPA of 3.37, the highest score in northeast India. The National Institutional Ranking Framework placed it at 34th among colleges in India in 2023, the only college within the top 100 list, and thus, the highest rank from Northeast India. The college also organizes seminars / workshops / conferences / trainings at various levels- International / National / State levels. The college offers undergraduate courses in 23 subject areas of Arts, Science, Commerce and Management.
