As the only Constituent College of Mizoram University, PUC offers Undergraduate courses in 23 subject areas of Arts, Science, Commerce, and Management, and has PG classes in Philosophy, Mizo, and Life Science. Established in 1958 as Aijal College, it later became the first postgraduate college in Mizoram by offering master's degree courses. PUC has received recognition and awards for its conservation efforts, including the Indira Priyadarshini Vrikshamitra Awards, and has been acknowledged as a college with potential for excellence by the University Grants Commission. Moreover, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council has accredited PUC with an A+ rating, and it was ranked 45th in NIRF 2022.

About Department Of Public Administration: The Department of Public Administration was founded in 2005 at Pachhunga University College, owing to the remarkable contributions of Prof. A.K. Sharma, who held the position of Vice Chancellor at Mizoram University, and under the guidance of Dr. H. Lallungmuana, the then College Principal. As a recently introduced department, it marked the 19th departmental offering of the college. On 6th June 2005, the inaugural classes were initiated, welcoming the admission of BA I Students, denoting the commencement of the department's academic voyage.
