Election Rules:

- 1. Students who have attended PUC for at least one academic year are eligible to contest the election (according to article 7(2) of the SU Constitution)
- 2. A candidate must have cleared all papers in the University Examinations; any backlog of papers shall render him or her disqualified.
- 3. A candidate must have attained a good attendence record. He/she must have satisfied the university norms (75%) in the preceding semesters.
- 4. Although all eligible students, regardless for sex or caste can contest for any post, posts such as Cultural Secretary and Debating Secretary (with their counterpart secretaries) shall be reserved for girls, on rotation basis; i.e. if Cultural Secretary is reserved for one tenure, post of Debating Secretary shall be reserved for the next term, but not all the same time.
- 5. Attendance shall be taken at the Declaration of Results.
- 6. Campaign may be allowed without disturbing regular classes. Students should produce identity cards/registration cards at the time of casting votes.
- 7. Casting of votes shall be done at every departmental classroom with a specific voting application provided in official laptop.
- 8. Nomination form shall be obtained from establishment section of the college office and have to be submitted to the same.
