About the Host Institution

Pachhunga University College (PUC) is a constituent college of the Mizoram University, a Central University established by an Act of Parliament of India. It is the grandest and a premier institute in the entire state of Mizoram. The college campus is covered with a verdant reserve of forest makes a serene environment and picturesque scenery. The college has been awarded A+ grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2016 and granted ‘College with Potential for Excellence’ by UGC. The College is also ISO 9001:2015 certified since 2018. The institution has also been identified as a potential ‘Mentor Institution’ to help the NAAC aspiring institutions. It also remains the only institute of higher education in Mizoram to run under-graduate courses in three disciplines, namely Arts, Science and Commerce. The college also currently has 6 add on courses and runs UGC Community College- Diploma in Mushroom Cultivation course. The college is also selected under DBT “Star College Scheme” 2019-20. The college also received ‘Indira Gandhi NSS Awards’ in 2016 for its outstanding contribution to the service of the community at various levels. It also remains the only institution in Mizoram to have been awarded the prestigious Indira Priyadarshini Vriksha Mitra (IPVM) in 1995, the national award for pioneering and innovative contribution in the field of afforestation/wasteland management from the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India.

Destination & Accommodation

The capital city of Mizoram, Aizawl can be reached by air from Kolkata, Guwahati and Imphal, and by road from Guwahati via Shillong and Silchar. Silchar is the nearest railway station – about 184 km away from Aizawl. Buses and maxi cabs are available from Guwahati (18-20 hrs journey) via Shillong (12-15 hrs) and Silchar (06-08 hrs).

Accommodation can be arranged on request upon remittance of advance payment of booking charge Rs. 1000/- along with the registration fee.
