We the panel of Assessors after thoroughly examining Format-I (Institutional Data) and Format – II (Departmental) of the Academic & Administrative Audit of Pachhunga University College have determined the following observations and recommendations.

OBSERVATIONS:

- I. Curricular Aspect: Institute adopted and implemented successfully the NEP based curricula and maintains good academic record. A high pass percentage is recorded across the departments. However, academic flexibility is further be expanded and more add on courses be introduced. Intake and seats filled needs to be maintained rationally.
- II. Teaching, Learning and Evaluation: Academic diaries and other activities in the department well maintained. The internal assessment is well conducted and remedial classes are conducted regularly The assessment of the remedial classes and internal assessment be further analysed and documented for valid outcome.
- III. Research, Innovation and Extension: College promotes fairly good research activities and outcome is visible with a large number of research projects and the extramural funding to several departments. Research publications are reported by several departments however; more number of Scopus and WoS papers need to be published by the faculties. Moreover, the consultancy is not initiated. NSS, NCC and other cells are active and performing appropriately.
- IV. Infrastructure, Learning and Resources: Fairly good infrastructure is available in the college. Classrooms are equipped with the ICT tools and adequate number of laboratories are in place. The number of computers for the students is adequate and 100 mbps network is provided through LAN. Library is having good number of tiles and automated fully. Sports infrastructure is good but needs to be upgraded. Language Lab is not in place and students' centre need to be introduced to meet various students' requirements. The facilities for the PwDs need further improvements.
- V. Students Support and Progression: College provides fairly good support to the students for their sports activities. However, a well-structured support system be created for the carrer counselling and guidance for competitive examinations. Grievance redressal system is well placed and reflected with the amicable redressal performed in the college.
- VI. Governance, Leadership and Management: The college is under the MZU hence, a proper governace and leadership is in place. Various employees' and students' welfare schemes are implemented without any discrimination. A participative governance helps in smooth functioning of the college.
- VII. Institutional Values and Best Practices: The college showed various outreach and extension activities for the society. The outcome of these activities is quite visible. College achieved

good number of awards and achievements during the assessment period. The distinctiveness of college be properly outlined for greater outcome.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. The outcome of the Remedial classes and coaching be critically analysed for explicit outcome of these programs.
2. The PO, PSO and COs be collected and implemented for its attainment.
3. The college needs the structured following facilities:
 - (i) Solid waste management
 - (ii) Liquid Waste management
 - (iii) E-Waste Management
 - (iv) Bio Waste Management
 - (v) Chemical Waste Management
4. The IKS and R&D Cell should be given priority in the college
5. The extra space be given to promote the research activities in the college
6. The Eligible teachers be encouraged to produce more number of PhDs either as full-fledged supervisor or Co-supervisor
7. The Scopus and WoS publications be encouraged in the college
8. The extramural funding further be increased and almost all departments must bring projects.
9. The library openings be initiated during offtime as well during holidays if possible.
10. The Consultancy work should be encouraged.
11. Alumni contribution is meagre and seems no registered alumni cell is in place.
12. Add on courses be increased and if possible every semester at least one add on course be introduced by each academic department.
13. The synchronization of education with various skill courses be introduced.
14. Swayam and other online courses be encouraged in the college.
15. Teachers be advised to prepare Swayam courses.
16. LMS system, if possible, be introduced.
17. Language Laboratory be introduced.




