## REPORT 9<sup>TH</sup> FINISHING SCHOOL PACHHUNGA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

The 9<sup>th</sup> Finishing School was held from 31<sup>st</sup> May- 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. 24 (twenty four) students enrolled for the school, and 13 (thirteen) classes were conducted by 13 (thirteen) Resource Persons.
