

Global Youth Summit 2025

Global Youth Summit 2025, hosted by the State NSS Cell, Department of Youth Empowerment and Sports: Government of Karnataka, in association with NSS of Yenepoya (Deemed to be University), was successfully held at Yendurance Zone, Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) Mangalore, Karnataka, during June 5 & 6, 2025. This International Conference was attended by the following students selected from Pachhunga University College, Aizawl who represented Mizoram NSS Cell:

Delegates from 19 countries participated in this summit with the theme and main slogan of the Summit being **“Youth Power: Innovate, Inspire, Impact”** with sub themes like Social Entrepreneurship and Innovation, Green India, Empowering Rural Youth, Youth in Governance, Technological Innovation and Building a healthy Nation.

The Journey: Five Representatives from Mizoram (3 from PUC and 2 from GZRSC) started the journey to Mangalore on 31st May, traveling by bus from Aizawl to Guwahati, and boarded a train for their journey from Guwahati to Bengaluru, which started on 1st June in Guwahati and reached Bengaluru on 3rd June. Then at the same night, a train from Bengaluru to Mangalore was boarded, with the representatives arriving at the designated place on 4th June, 2025 at about 8 a.m. The journey back starts on the evening of 7th June from Mangalore to Bengaluru by train, with 2 days stay at Bengaluru, and on 10th June taking a train from Bengaluru, the representatives of the College reached Guwahati on 12th June. Taking bus on the evening of 12th June, the representatives arrived back to Aizawl on the dawn of 14th June.

The Overall Program: On the date of arrival, the delegates were allocated to their respective accommodations provided by Yenepoya (Deemed to be University), which was followed by an Auspicious Inaugural Session on the evening of 4th June, 2025. The main session on 5th and 6th June involves paper presentations by distinguished guests and resource persons such as Successful Entrepreneurs, Sportsperson, Academicians and even Chancellors of Universities. The presentations were followed by Panel Discussions, opening Q & A sessions, fostering constructive dialogues and imparting motivations and knowledge among the delegates who attended the Summit.



The Global Youth Summit, 2025 was graced by the presence of Shri. Dinesh Gundu Rao, Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of Karnataka. Moreover, poster presentations competition was also held on different sub-themes of the Summit, where delegates participated. At the end of each technical sessions, a vibrant and dynamic Cultural Session was held which showcased various cultural traditions and dances of different countries and different states across India.

The NSS of Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) welcomed the delegates greatly with its hostel facilities and food, along with free pickup and drop by buses within Mangalore. Delegates were also given the opportunity of visiting Polali Rajarajeshwari Temple and Thannirbavi beach. The journey of this NSS program was not without challenges, with its long durations of travel time with trains and buses, but the experiences that one achieves from it and the valuable lessons learnt from the Summit and also the journey will be cherished and remembered for years to come.
