Blood Donation Camp was organised by NSS PUC Unit on 14th and 30th September, 2021. In keeping with the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) laid out by the state government, it was decided that different days would be allotted to the different departments of the college. The first day of the Blood Donation Camp was held on 14th September, 2021 (Tuesday). The opening of programme was held at 10:00 a.m where the Principal Prof. H. Lalthanzara, gave a speech in which he encouraged the NSS volunteers to be an important part of society. He thanked the volunteers for their contribution in the previous years where the college had gained recognition because of the huge number of blood units donated voluntarily.
