## **CLEANING OF PUBLIC PLACES & COLLEGE CAMPUS**

### CLEANLINESS DRIVE IN KAWLTHEIHUAN, MISSON VENG on 24th March, 2022

On 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2022, NSS PUC unit organized a cleanliness drive in Kawltheihuan, Misson Veng locality. Twenty (20) volunteers (12 M and 8 F) participated in the program. The volunteers covered the community hall and streets of Kawltheihuan and non-biodegradable wastes were collected and deposited in Aizawl Municipal solid waste dump site (**Picture 1**).

#### CLEANLINESS DRIVE IN RAJIV GANDHI STADIUM on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022

On 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022, the volunteers and Programme officers of NSS PUC unit had a cleanliness drive in and around Rajiv Gandhi Stadium, Mualpui, Aizawl (Picture 2). Three Programme officers and 30 volunteers (22 Male and 8 Female) participated in the program. Garbage were picked covering the playground, the running track and the sitting area. The collected trashes were packed in garbage bags and left for the Aizawl municipal solid waste dumping site.

#### CLEANLINESS DRIVE IN COLLEGE CAMPUS on 31st March 2022.

On 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022, NSS volunteers gathered for a cleanliness drive in the college campus where 72 (37 male and 35 female) participated in the program. The volunteers were divided into two groups:

The first group consist of 32 volunteers where 18 of them were male and 14 were female (**Picture 3**). They have collected the biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes covering the campus internal streets and in and around Chemical science building. They were guided by the NSS P.Os and the teachers of Chemistry department.
