

Pachhunga University College Unit Special camping at Nausel village 2022

NSS Special Camping was held in Nausel village on 28th March, 2022 where 43 volunteers and 7 Programme Officers participated in the program. Among the volunteers 18 were female and 32 were male. Nausel is a village consist of around 70 houses, street campaign was organised with the help of the village council members. The volunteers and the P.Os. spent the time for awareness campaign on different topics. Due to the pandemic, it was not possible to hold a public gathering, therefore, a street campaign was organised so that people could listen from the comforts of their home. Three Programme Officers and four volunteers gave speeches on different topics which covered Rain Water Harvesting and Maintenance of water reservoirs, River rejuvenation, Tree Plantation, Fire Prevention. Pamphlets on these topics were also distributed and posters for awareness on these topics were pasted in many places in the village.


