

The workshop was graced by the Guest of honour Dr. RK Lallianthanga, Chief Scientific officer, Dept. of Science and Technology, Mizoram. Dr. Tawnenga, Principal, Pachhunga University College, Aizawl in his inaugural speech highlight an overview of the research works undergoing at present as well as in the past.

He talks in length on the necessity of faculty member to carry out research work in order to update them with fast changing pace of the globalized world. He also encouraged all the young investigators and researcher of the college with various beautiful proverbs and quotes. Mrs. Lalhlimmpuii, Vice Principal of the college, in her welcome address urged to all the participants to utilized maximum benefit from the workshop. She also highlighted the importance of the research work in the academic life. Dr. RK Lallianthanga in his inaugural address highlight the thrust areas of the sciences where the young investigators can take up research works in the future like geological sciences, life sciences and physical sciences etc. taking in special consideration of the resources available and problems currently facing by the state of Mizoram. He also advised all the young teachers to work collaboratively so that the output of the research can be reached to the common people of the state and country at large.

The first technical session of the seminar was started with the Key note talks from Prof. Diwankar Tiwari, Head of Department, Department of Chemistry, Mizoram University, Aizawl on the topic "Impact of Research on Higher Education". He talked in length about the role of research in the teacher's informed teaching activities in the classroom, parameters in the National Institute Framework Ranking (NIFR) introduced under HRD, Government of India and the how the quality research output plays an important component in getting good ranking of the Institutions under NIFR. He also urged young investigators of the college to judiciously used Intellectual Property Right (IPR) and applied for patent for any products comes out from the research. After that various PIs including one DST's women scientist present the progress report of their research project works on the various topics ranges from DNA barcoding of fishes, antimalarial drugs, Cross border state studies and Institutional Biotech Hub undergoing in the college. All the PIs highlighted not only the progress report but also future work plans and problem faced if any during the implementation of the project work. Each presentation was followed by constructive discussion with the PIs and the participants.

The second technical session was started with an Invited lecture delivered by Prof. N. He highlights to the participants about the techniques of effective presentation and how to prepare quality slides etc. He also talk in length about how to write a research grant as well as research articles, what are the important components of a research grant and review as well as original research articles to the young investigators present in the workshop. The major highlight of the sub technical session of the afternoon session were progress reports presentation from the PIs of various major research projects undergoing in the college with topics ranges from Nematodes of Mizoram, Study of the physiochemical parameters of Tamdil lake, Gene expression studies and DNA barcoding of earthworm of North East etc. There was a fruitful deliberation between the PIs and external experts as well as with the participants about the methodology of the research works, future course of works and innovative ideas and emerging concept which can be incorporated in their project work for better and quality output. The workshop was come to end with certificate distribution to the participants by Dr. H. Lalthanzara, Coordinator of the workshop and a short Vote of Thanks addressed by Dr. K. Birla Singh, Secretary, of the workshop. The Worksop was concluded with light refreshments.
