Introduction:

An educational tour was held for the 5th semester students of the Department of Zoology, Pachhunga University College on the 4th of December 2017 to the 7th of December 2017 (Four days) to Shillong, Meghalaya. A total of twenty-five (25) students were accompanied by two teaching faculties. Lodging was at the Old Guest House of North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong, Meghalaya. The various science departments and the laboratories of NEHU were visited. Sophisticated instruments not available in Mizoram were observed by the students with detailed on the spot lecture by the accompanying faculties.
